PARTICIPANTS

Athletes who meet the following criteria may participate in the Games:

- must be a representative of a national federation, or a member of a club with membership in a national federation;
- the age and level of training shall conform to the requirements and regulations of the sport included in the Games programme.

REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

The registration for all delegation members is mandatory and carried out online in the Accreditation System used by the Organising Committee.

AQUATICS PALACE, GENERAL INFORMATION



Location:

70, S. Khakima Str., Kazan

Venue Description

Aquatics Palace is the largest indoor aquatics facility in Russia. It was built within the preparations for the 27th Summer Universiade 2013 to host the competitions in artistic swimming, diving, swimming, and water polo.

Venue has unique characteristics for holding the competitions of any level and staging water shows – 4 swimming pools, a diving zone, movable floor (diving pool, main swimming pool), modern underwater sound system.

Aquatics Palace regularly hosts different FINA competitions as well as Russian championships in diving, swimming, artistic swimming. The venue is also a home arena for the student teams of the Volga Region University of Physical Culture, Sport and Tourism (swimming and water polo) and a base for the training camps of a number of sports teams at regional and national levels

Technical information

Athletes' preparation area (locker rooms, dry lands) is located on the ground floor as well as competition management offices and doping control area. Press centre with a conference hall and VIP zone are located on the 3rd floor, 2nd and 4th floors are dedicated to spectators.

Seating capacity: 4,100 seats

Parking: over 300 cars.

Venue is accessible to the disabled people.

“BUREVESTNIK” SWIMMING POOL, GENERAL INFORMATION



Venue Description

“Burevestnik” Swimming Pool is located in the Universiade Village.

Venue is designed for the competitions in swimming (25m), artistic swimming, water polo, and scuba diving. It features a 50m swimming pool, universal sports hall with TeraflexSport M Performance flooring (volleyball,

basketball, futsal), dry swimming hall with parquet flooring, a gym.

Seating capacity: 900 seats

Parking: over 150 cars.

Venue is accessible to the disabled people.

MEDICAL SERVICES

A medical room will be functioning at the competition venues. Medical care will be additionally provided by the mobile medical teams, as well as emergency medical service teams. If necessary, hospitalisation will be carried out into one of the accredited hospitals in Kazan. A rescue team will be on duty during the competitions and trainings period.

Emergency medical care is available 24/7 on call. The medical emergency cell phone numbers are 103, 030, 112.

Anti-doping control is performed with due account for the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) requirements.

COVID-19 RELATED INFORMATION

To avoid the risks of getting infected with coronavirus, there are a number of restrictions and measures:

1. Entry to the competition venue – after thermometry.

2. Not visiting places of mass gathering outside the accommodation facility and competition venue as well as informing the head of delegation in case of the onset of the disease symptoms.

Detailed information will be available at a later stage before the Games.

COMPETITORS AND TEAM OFFICIALS SEATING

The seats for competitors and coaches will be provided at the main stands. Competitors and their coaches will be allowed to seat at the poolside.

SPORTS INFORMATION DESK

Information centres will be located at the competitions venues.

ACCREDITATION DESK

Accreditation badge is the only official document for the Event. Badges are personal (personalised) and are not transferable to third parties.

Accreditation badges are issued to the participants who have timely and successfully completed the registration procedure in the Accreditation System (Individual Form

should be in the "Active" status).

Accreditation Centre is located in the territory of the sports venue (Aquatics Palace). Accreditation Centre working hours will be adjusted as per the training and competition schedule.

The Organising Committee recommends one (1) responsible person to collect the originals of passports for all arrived members of the delegations and collect all the badges. The physical presence of athletes and officials in the Accreditation Centre is not required.

RULES

Competitions by sports will be organised in compliance with the Event regulations as per the latest technical rules that adhere to the requirements of international and national sports federations.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

1. Swimming:

National (Russian) Technical Officials are appointed by the Russian Swimming Federation.

2. Artistic Swimming:

National (Russian) Technical Officials are appointed by the Russian Synchronised Swimming Federation. A country participating in the Artistic Swimming competition must provide one international category judge in its delegation. The Organising Committee is responsible to pay for travel to and from the Games, accommodation, meals and on-site transportation of International Technical Officials.

In case the participating country is unable to bring a judge of the appropriate category in the delegation, the Organising Committee has the right to replace them with a national judge.

3. Diving:

National (Russian) Technical Officials are appointed by the Russian Diving Federation.

A country participating in the Diving competition must provide one international category judge in its delegation. The Organising Committee is responsible to pay for travel to and from the Games, accommodation, meals and on-site transportation of International Technical Officials.

In case the participating country is unable to bring a judge of the appropriate category in the delegation, the Organising Committee has the right to replace them with a national judge.

VISA INFORMATION

Games participants must have a valid Russian visa to enter and stay in the country.

The Organising Committee will facilitate an entry visa to Kazan, Russia, by providing the official Letter of Invitation for all participants of the Games who have successfully requested one and completed their registration in the System.

Please make sure that the visa mandatory fields (i.e. personal data and contacts, scan of the valid passport) are completed correctly and up to date in the System. Please note that the passport expiry date must be no earlier than 1 June 2023 (for II stage "Sport") and no earlier than 22 June 2023 (for III stage "Legends").

Based on the data received, the Organising Committee will send the official Letter of Invitation to the participants by e-mail.

After receiving the Letter of Invitation, the participants must collect all documents in accordance with the requirements of the Embassy/Consulate of the Russian Federation and submit the documents together with the Letter of Invitation issued by the Organising Committee to the Embassy/Consulate of the Russian Federation no earlier than one month before the event.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE PARTICIPANTS' TRAVEL

To book and execute the economy railway and air tickets to Kazan and back, the participants need to fill in and submit the "Flight ticket request" along with the copies of the valid passports to the Organising Committee's e-mail nationalfederations@dspkazan.com as per the following deadlines:

1. For the foreign participants who require visa support: no later than 9 October 2022 (for the II stage "Sport") and no later than 8 November 2022 (for the III stage "Legends");
2. For other participants: no later than 16 October 2022 (for the II stage "Sport") and no later than 15 November 2022 (for the III stage "Legends").

Within three days upon returning from Kazan, the participants shall submit original copies of the

boarding passes for each travel segment from Kazan to the Organising Committee: by post (to the following address: Kazan, Republic of Tatarstan, Russia, 420010, Universiade Village, 35, ANO "Directorate for Sports and Social Projects") and by e-mail (scanned copies shall be sent to the e-mail i.shakirov@dspkazan.com)



IMPORTANT: Participants who have been provided with travel tickets shall keep boarding passes for all travel segments to Kazan and back. Upon arrival in Kazan, the participants shall submit railway tickets or boarding passes for each flight/trip segment to the Organising Committee staff at the Kazan International Airport or Kazan Railway Station.

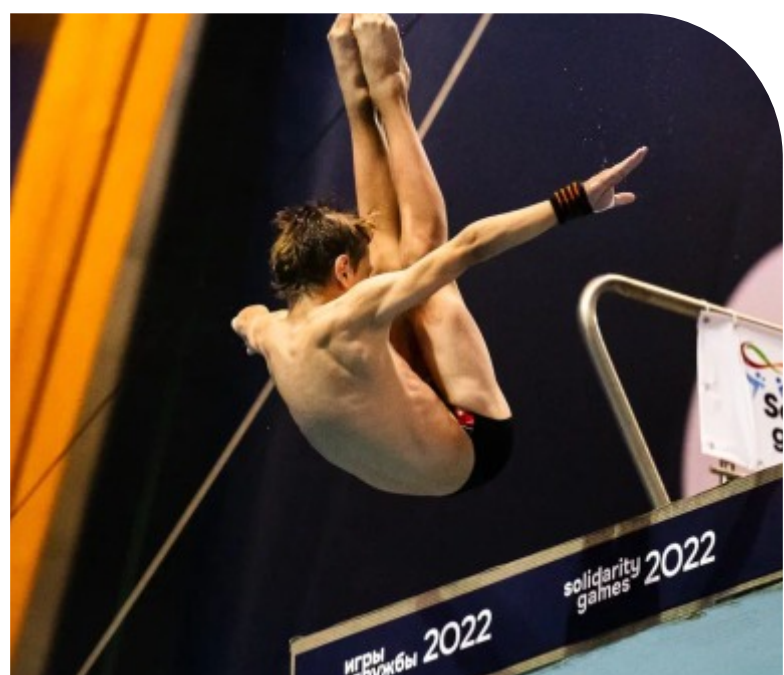

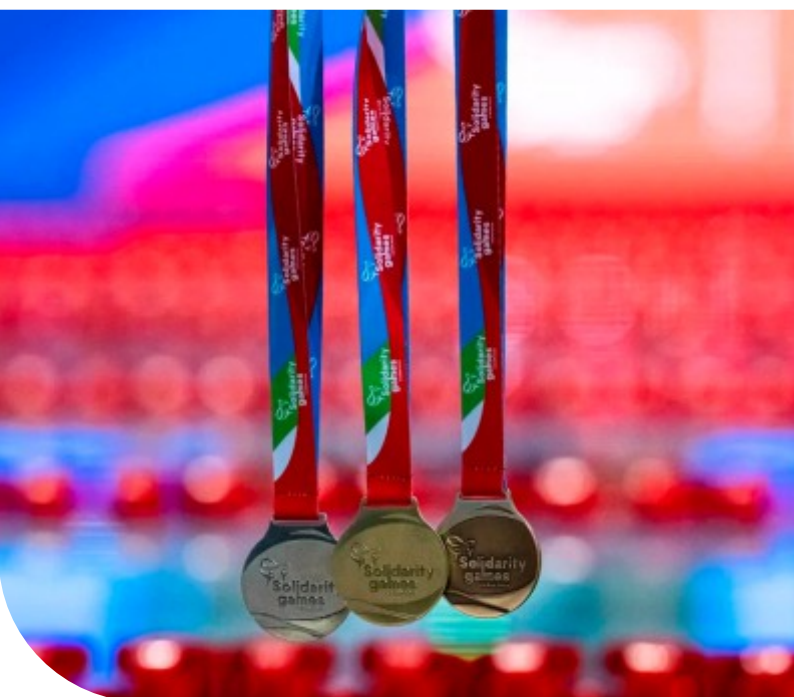
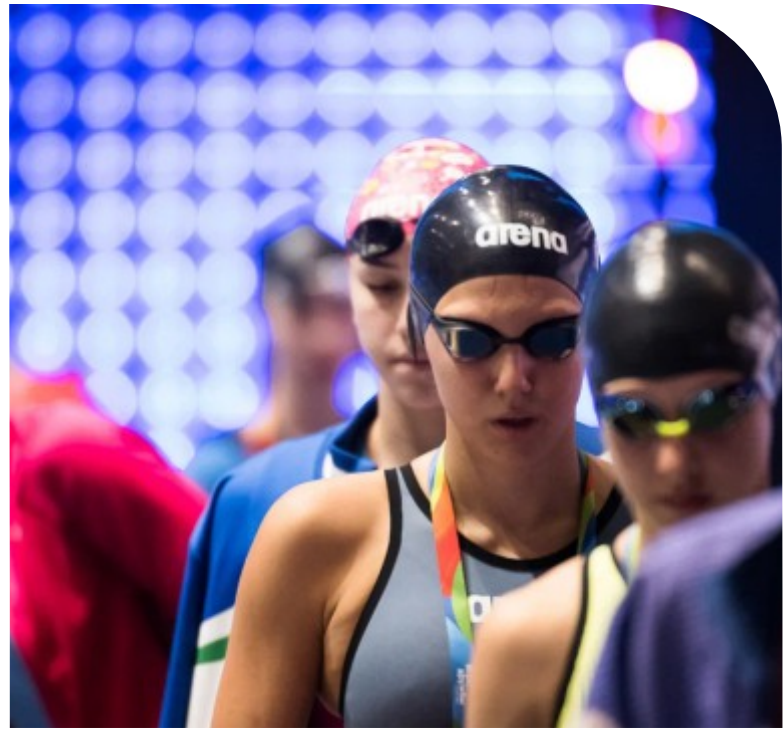
